Assessment Task: Concord - a game forward

Concord

Refer to the rules to complete the activity:

1. Find the subject (ask who or what before the verb)
2. Decide whether the subject is singular or plural. (The boy/The boys)
3. The verb must match the subject (singular subject singular verb)
4. The pronoun must agree with the noun, e.g. The **lady** washes **her** car.

Activity 1

Work in groups of four.

Each person in the group has a turn to provide an answer. The group will discuss the answer and agree/disagree.

After discussion, a final decision must be made and the whole group fills in the answer on their worksheets.

The values of good manners, listening skills and participation must be emphasised.
