

Grade 7 Life Orientation Worksheet

1. Prepare a poster about the causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS.
2. Cover the following topics:
 - What is HIV/AIDS?
 - What are the causes of HIV/AIDS?
 - How can HIV/AIDS be prevented?
3. When preparing your poster:
 - Draw or cut out pictures from pamphlets, newspapers and magazines.
 - Make sure that your headings are larger than the rest of your writing.
 - Plan your poster! Make sure all the facts that belong together are under the same heading.
 - Don't "overcrowd" your poster with information and pictures. It must be clear to everyone what your poster is all about.

Your teacher will use the checklist below to assess your poster. Talk about this checklist before you start making your poster so that you can see how you will be assessed.
