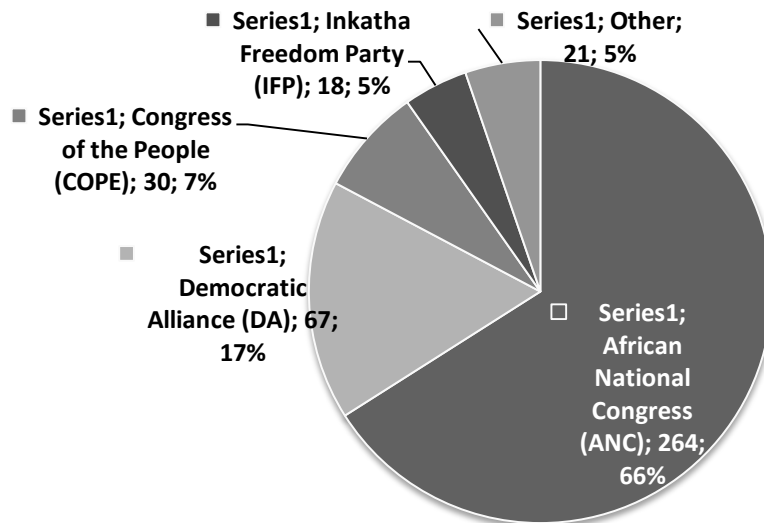

**Election results
for South Africa
2009**

The graph above shows the breakdown of the election results in South Africa in 2009. According to this pie chart, which of the following statements is **not true**?

- A) 34% of the nation that did not vote for the ANC.
- B) The DA is the official opposition.
- C) About 30 million South Africans voted in the last election.
- D) If all the opposition parties dissolved into one party, then this opposition party would be much stronger.

Grade 7 Maths Worksheet

Solution

1. A: $17\% + 7\% + 5\% + 5\% = 34\%$ - True.
 B: DA has 17% which is more than COPE and IFP, but less than ANC making them the official opposition - True
 C: Numbers on people voting is not available - Not necessarily true
 D: An opposition with 34% will be stronger than any of the present opposition parties - True
 Solution is (C).
