

Grade 7 Life Orientation Worksheet

Values - cheating

Role-play in a simulated situation (Group activity)

Have you ever cheated in a game or a test? Have you ever cheated on the sports field? Have you ever been part of a team who cheated? How did it make you feel? If you win when you have cheated, do you think it really feels like a win?

Activity

- Divide into groups of about 4 people per group.
- Discuss fair and unfair play.
- Discuss various situations and decide whether there was fair or unfair play involved.
- Simulate fair play as a role-play activity.
- Present your role-play activity to the rest of the class.
- The class will discuss your role-plays after each performance.
