

## Grade 9 Life Orientation Worksheet

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### Social responsibility on role play

Work in small groups of 4 to 6 to work out a role-play in which you take on different roles within social relationships. First decide what the social relationship is. It could be a family relationship, a sports relationship, an interest group such as an art club or a chess club, or any other social relationship. Once you have decided on the social relationship, decide on a situation to portray, the roles each of you will take on and how you will each play these roles.

You are going to present your role-plays in front of the class. Your class members will give feedback after each role-play. Your teacher will assess the role-plays using the checklist below.
