

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Suggested Solutions

Question number	Possible marks	Solution
1	8	<p>Farmers plant and produce cotton which they sell to factories and get paid for</p>  <p>Factories use cotton to produce material which they sell to T-shirt manufacturers</p> <p>Consumers pay for T-shirts and put money into the economy, which is used for more production</p> <p>T-shirt manufacturers buy material from factories, make T-shirts and sell these to consumers</p>

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
